The biscuits are produced in Sungai Lembing, a tin mining town 42 kilometres northwest of Kuantan in Pahang, Malaysia.

Production and processing

Biskut dan san Sungai Lembing is a coconut biscuit that is traditionally made using water from the Sungai Lembing waterfall. Since this water is free from chlorine, the final result is very crunchy.

Link between product and territory

Until the 1970s, Sungai Lembing was a major producer of underground tin. It more recent times, it has become a tourist attraction.
