Main characteristics/features

Halia Bentong refers to ginger. It is light yellow in colour, spicy, and its fibres are fine and watery.

Geographical area

Halia Bentong is produced in Bentong, Pahang, Malaysia.

Production and processing

Bentong ginger grows in an area located at 700 metres above sea level, where the average rainfall is about 187 millimetres a month or 2 200 millimetres a year. Temperatures vary between 24 degrees Celsius and 28 degrees Celsius.

The fertile soil and cold weather are ideal conditions for the ginger trees to grow.

Link between product and territory

Ginger has been planted in Bentong since 1963. The Chinese were the first group of farmers to start planting ginger trees there.

The geographical conditions of the area are very conducive to the successful cultivation of ginger.
