Main characteristics/features

The boats at Pulau Duyong are built without using a set plan. They are built entirely from the memory of the skilled shipwright involved.

Geographical area

Pulau Duyong boats are produced on Duyong Island, in Terengganu, on the east coast of Malaysia.

Production and processing

The preferred material used to make the hulls is cengal, a durable wood that is impervious to termite attacks. After the hull planking is fastened with strong hardwood pegs, a special sealant is applied. Once the frame is fitted to the boat, it gives the whole structure strength and flexibility.

As construction takes place in dry dock, the finished boats have to be manoeuvred on rollers into the water.

Link between product and territory

The art of traditional boat making has always been at the heart of Pulau Duyong's local heritage.
