Main characteristics/features

Nasi dagang is a traditional food of the people of Kuala Terengganu. It is a combination of steamed rice, tuna fish and pickle.

Geographical area

The geographical area is located in Terengganu.

Production and processing

The white rice is soaked first and subsequently steamed with glutinous rice and coconut milk.

Once it is cooked, fenugreek, ginger and shallots are added.

Link between product and territory

Nasi dagang is usually eaten for breakfast or lunch. This dish is also served during special festivals, namely on the morning of Eid ul-Fitr, a Muslim festival to mark the end of Ramadan.

The most famous nasi dagang is from Kampung Ladang, which is one of the districts in Kuala Terengganu.
