Main characteristics/features

Sakon Nakhon Mulberry (Mak Mao Sakon Nakhon) is a Mak Mao Luang variety with small round, thin-skinned berries that grow in clusters. When ready to harvest, the berries are dark purple in colour. The fruit is sweet, sour, astringent or bitter with a distinctive fragrance.

Geographical area

Sakon Nakhon province located in northeastern Thailand.

Production/processing

Link between product and territory

Sakon Nakhon province is a plain with undulations. The southern part of the province is a large plantation area. This province has a summer, winter and a rainy season. The heat and strong sunlight in the area are essential for the Mak Mao trees to produce their flowers and allow the fruit to start forming.
