Main characteristics/features

Khao Thalu Coffee (Kafae Khao Thalu) is a Robusta strain. It has an intense, bitter taste and a unique aroma. It is used to produce roasted coffee, ground coffee and instant coffee.

Geographical area

The coffee farming area covers the Khao Thalu subdistrict of Chumphon, at an attitude of approximately 200-300 metres above sea level. The province itself is located to the west of the upper south of Thailand.

Production/processing

Link between product and territory

The soil in the area of the Khao Thalu subdistrict is naturally fertilised and contains guano. The area is very rainy, with 8 months of rain and 4 months of sunshine. These conditions contribute to the specific characteristics of the Robusta coffee grown in the area.
