Banmai Sapodilla (Lamut Banmai) is a Makok variety with an oval shape like the hog plum. It has a thin brown peel with firm, fine, crisp, sweet and fragrant flesh.

Sapodillas have been grown in Banmai sub-district of Pra Nakhon Sri Ayuttaya province for more than 100 years. The area is a naturally fertilised piece of land next to several rivers. Alluvium that is brought into the area by the tides of the Chao Phraya River and some of the canals are also essential for the cultivation of sapodillas in the area.
