Main characteristics/features

Bang Mod Tangerine (Som Bang Mod) has a unique cracked pattern to it. The peel of the tangerine is rather thin and easy to peel. It also has little fibre, orange colour flesh with a sweet-sour taste.

Geographical area

Bang Mod Tangerine is grown in Chom Thong, Thung Khru, Rat Burana, Bang Khun Thian, Bang Bon, Phasi Charoen, Bang Khae and Nong Khaem districts of Bangkok.

Production/processing

Link between product and territory

Most of the plantation area of Bang Mod Tangerine is close to and naturally fertilised by the Chao Phraya river. Soil in this area is in the Thonburi Soil series which combines high levels of potassium and phosphorus. The area has a low underground water level and also has stable night and daytime temperatures. In the rainy season, fresh water from the north runs through the area, and in the summer saltwater pushes back up into various canals and plantation areas and is called 'Luck Jued Luck Khem'. These factors create the unique taste of the Bang Mod Tangerine.
