Main characteristics/features

Geographical area

The Sisaket Volcanic Area Durian (Durian Phu Khao Fai Sisaket) is in Mon Thong, Cha Nee or Kan Yao varieties. Durians grown in the area are creamy and sweet in taste with a light fragrance. The pulp is fine, dry and yellow in colour.

The plantation areas cover the whole of Sisaket province in northeastern Thailand.

Production and processing

Link between product and territory

Sisaket province comprises plateaux and paddy fields. The soil in the area is red and naturally fertilised by the crushed basalt from an old volcano that was once active in the area. Temperatures are relatively hot in summer and cold in winter. All these factors contribute to the special characteristics of Sisaket Volcanic Area Durians.
