Main characteristics/features

The Sakaeo Nam Dok Mai mango (Ma Muang Nam Dok Mai Sakaeo) is of the Nam Dok Mai Si Thong and Nam Dok Mai Number 4 varieties. Characteristics of this type of mango include its oval shape and thin peel, which is golden-yellow when the fruit becomes ripe. It has yellow-orange flesh with very few fibrous strands, and a flat seed. The unripe fruit is normally sour, while the ripe ones are sweet with a pleasant aroma.

Geographical area

Sakaeo Nam Dok Mai mangoes are grown in Sakaeo province, in the eastern part of Thailand.

Production/processing

Link between product and territory

The types of soil in Sakaeo province consist of a mixture of loam and gravel or clay and gravel, which allow water to run through them easily. The soil also has high levels of nitrogen, which contributes to the fruit's sweetness. The area has a low rainfall, which helps the mango trees to produce more fruit instead of leaves.
