Main characteristics/features

The Rayong Golden Pineapple (Sab Pa Rod Thong Rayong) is a Queen variety pineapple. It is easy to distinguish as the tip of the leaf and crown of the fruit normally have short pinkish red thorns. The fruit is cylindrical in shape and has a thin skin with shallow bumps. When ready to harvest, the fruit turns golden in colour. The flesh is dark yellow, dense, dry, not too juicy and with a sharp-sweet taste. As the flesh is not very acidic, it irritates the consumer's mouth less.

Rayong Golden Pineapples are grown in Rayong province.

Production/processing

Link between product and territory

Rayong province has a combination of coastal plantation areas, naturally fertilised by the Rayong river that runs through them, and inland hillside areas that have good drainage. The soil in the area is slightly acidic sandy loam or sandy clay loam with good drainage and a high level of potassium and nitrogen. The province also has a considerable amount of rainfall each year. All of these factors contribute to the growing of a pineapple of distinct quality.
