#### Main characteristics/features

#### Geographical area

Bà Rịa - Vũng Tàu black pepper is whole-grained and dry seed fruit, firm corn (diameter of 3.2 to 5.8mm), having thin skin, colour of brown, gray or black, strong aroma and hot spiciness.

Pepper trees are planted on neutral brown-red soil which is naturally nutritious. The high temperature and humidity allows the pollens to stick to the pistils more easily, long pollination making pistil knob bigger, increasing the chances of conception and producing bigger embryo.

#### Production and processing

#### Link between product and territory

Variety: Lada Belantoeng pepper.  
Breeding season: November to February.  
Planting season: April to May.  
Density: 1,100 – 1,600 pillars per hectare.  
Harvest season: December to February when there are 5% are ripe fruit on each cluster. The pepper seeds are then dried for 3 – 4 days until the moisture is below 13%, the skin turn brown, gray or black.
